### **Wood County Sheriff to Speak at March Luncheon Meeting**

The March luncheon meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 21<sup>st</sup> at 11:45 a.m., at the Carranor Hunt and Polo Club, 502 East Second Street in Perrysburg. Wood County Sheriff Mark Wasylyshyn will be our guest speaker. He will discuss civilian response training including active shooter situations and more.

Mark Wasylyshyn is the elected Sheriff of Wood County Ohio since January of 2005. As the Sheriff, he is the chief law enforcement officer in the county, with additional responsibilities for managing the 224 bed county jail, 9-1-1 Dispatch Center, Special Response Team, Road Patrol, Detective Bureau, Sheriff Sales, courthouse complex security, issuing carry concealed weapons permits, registering and monitoring sex offenders and arsonists, and paper service for the Common Pleas Courts. He supervises a staff of 125 full-time deputies and is assisted by an auxiliary of forty members who volunteer their time. Sheriff Wasylyshyn is a life-long resident of Wood County.
