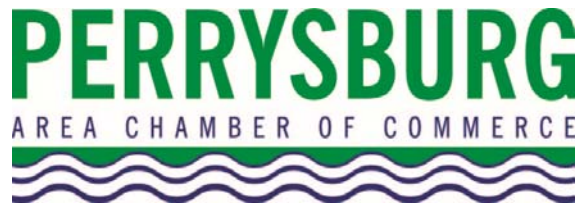

Sleep Specialist with Mercy Health to Speak at April 18th Luncheon Meeting Luncheon hosted by Cardinal Compliance Consultants

The April luncheon meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 18th at 11:30 a.m., at the Carranor Hunt and Polo Club, 502 East Second Street in Perrysburg. Dr. Michael Neeb, Sleep Specialist with Mercy Health will be our guest speaker. Dr. Neeb will speak about the importance of sleep in physical health, cognitive function, public safety, and workplace performance and productivity. He will also discuss how to get a good night's sleep!

Dr. Neeb is a clinical psychologist, currently the Regional Director of Sleep Services for Mercy Health in Toledo. He is the Director of three sleep centers within this system, and Co-Director of the Children's Sleep Disorders Clinic at Mercy Children's Hospital. He serves on the faculty of Mercy College of Northwest Ohio in the Sleep Technology Program.

Dr. Neeb is a graduate of Central Catholic High School and Bowling Green State University. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Delaware, and completed his internship in Behavioral Medicine at Johns Hopkins Hospital. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Sleep Medicine, Board Certified in Behavioral Sleep Medicine, and a Certified Clinical Trial Investigator. He has worked in the field of sleep for the past 30 years, with special interest in insomnia, circadian rhythm disorders, and childhood sleep.
